Benefits:

+ Improved access and connectivity

Provides one of the few north-south protected walking and cycling routes in the Central City.

Total foreshore accessible to the public increases by over 1000%.

Reduces distance for walking and cycling access into the heart of Camellia by 2km.

Access through Silverwater reduced by just under 1km and 8 less road crossings.

+ Health and liveability

Set within scenic parks and waterways, well-designed access encourages healthy lifestyles, connection with nature and social activity for all.

+ Green Infrastructure

The project improves the quality of riverside landscapes, enhancing biodiversity and habitat and increases opportunities for environmental and cultural heritage education.

+ Reduces congestion on local streets

Employees and residents are provided with a safe and pleasant alternative to driving, reducing the need to drive with the associated reduction in congestion and emissions.

+ Aligns with Local and State Government policies

The project supports the objectives of the Parramatta Bike Plan, Parramatta Ways, GSC Green Grid, TfNSW Future Transport and Draft DPIE Camellia-Rosehill Place Strategy.

Scope and Scale

- New bridge over Duck Creek
- 4.5km of new path and boardwalk
- Over half a kilometer of on street separated cycleway
- Large increase in number of street trees
