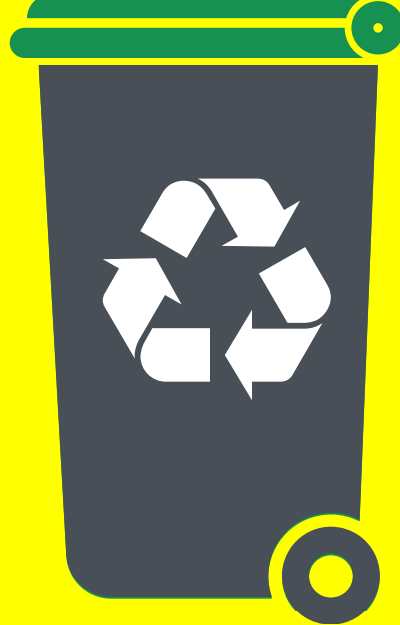


# FOGO WASTE COLLECTION

## 2022 COMMUNITY SURVEY RESULTS

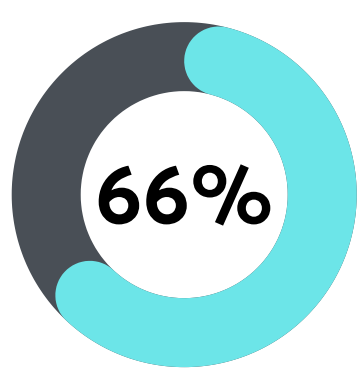
A Food & Garden Organics (FOGO) waste service will introduce a **weekly green bin service** helping to divert food waste from landfill.



Current data shows 43% of red bin contents is food waste.

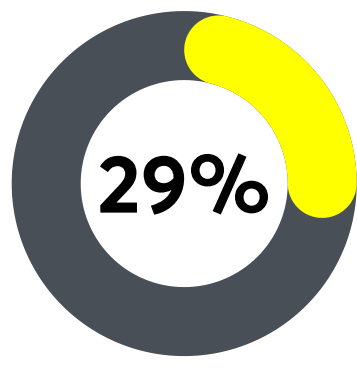
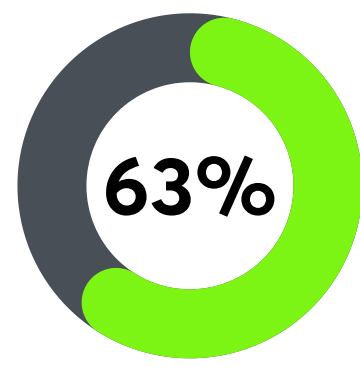
We asked you to comment on the introduction of a FOGO service and rate some options!

All options included a weekly green bin service. This meant the red-bin could change in size or frequency.



Had no concerns about the introduction of a FOGO service

Would like Council to provide a kitchen caddy



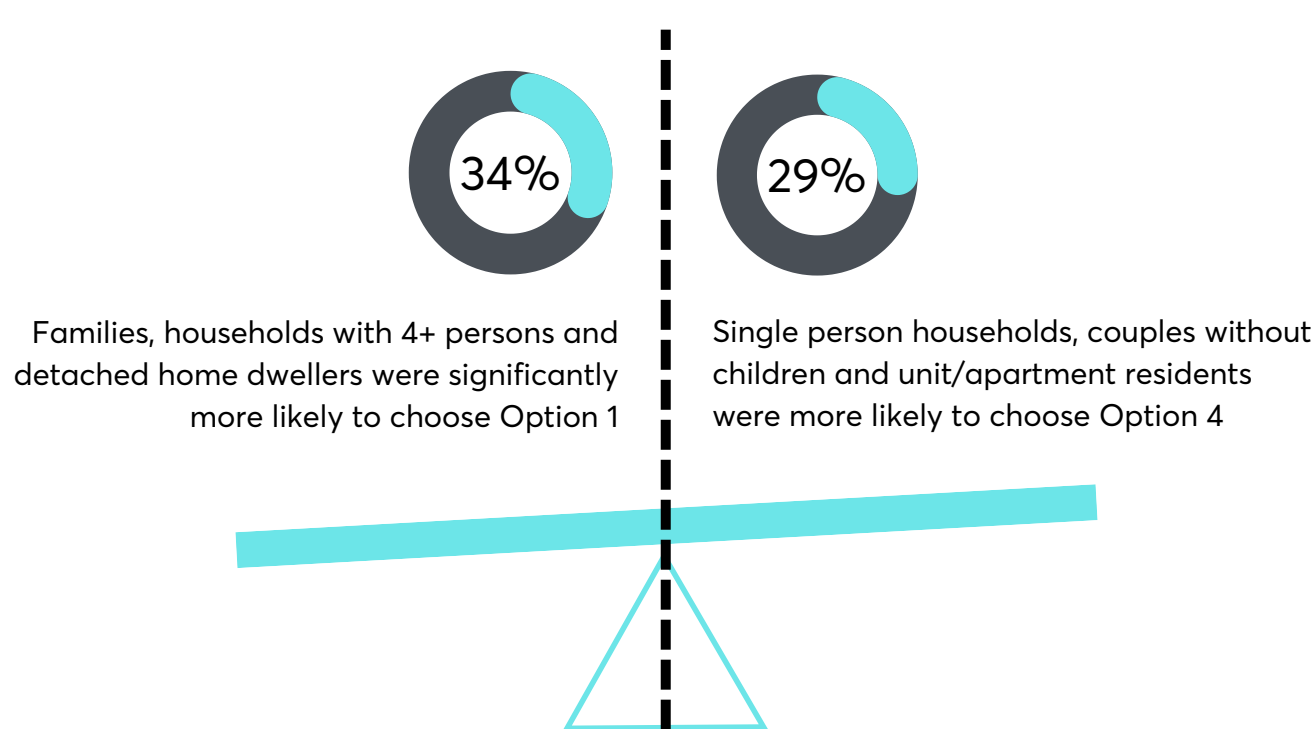
Had concerns about issues such as contamination and misuse, odour and pests.

Many suggested an **education and behaviour changing program** if FOGO is introduced.

The majority of survey respondents were willing to change their red-bin service but were split across the options.

Considering the four options, which do you prefer? You can only choose one option. (n=816)

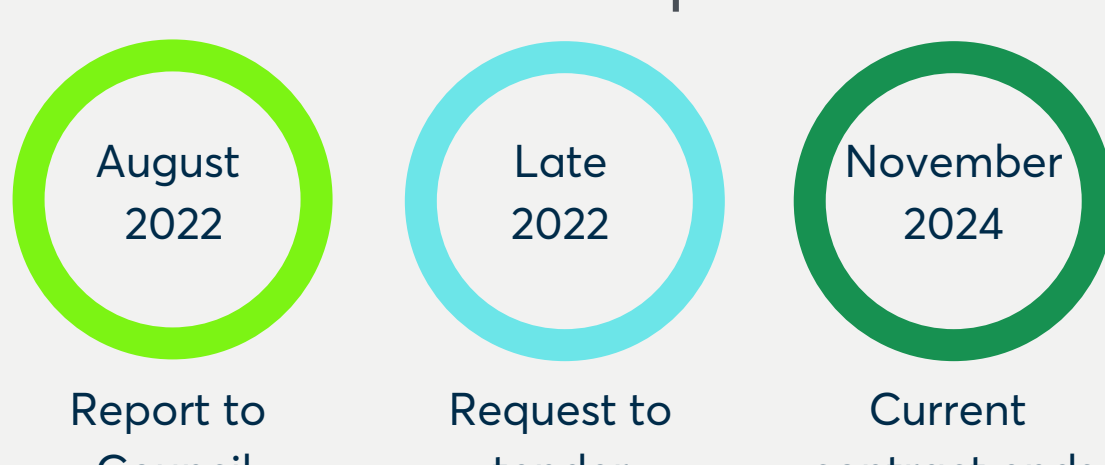
No change	Change to red-bin service
