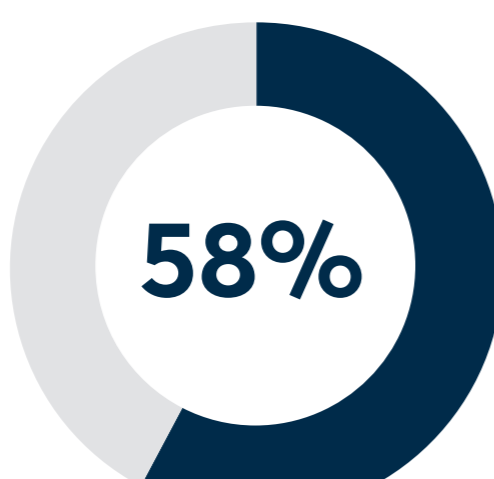

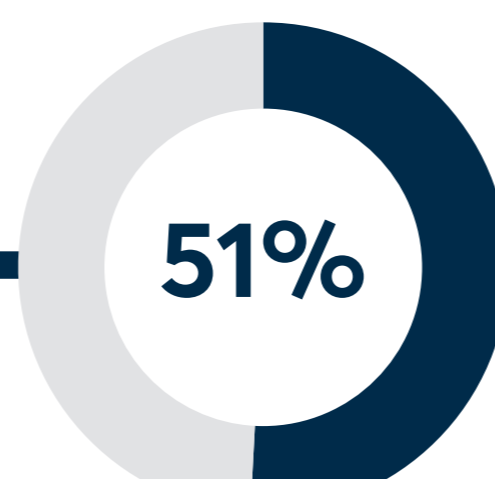

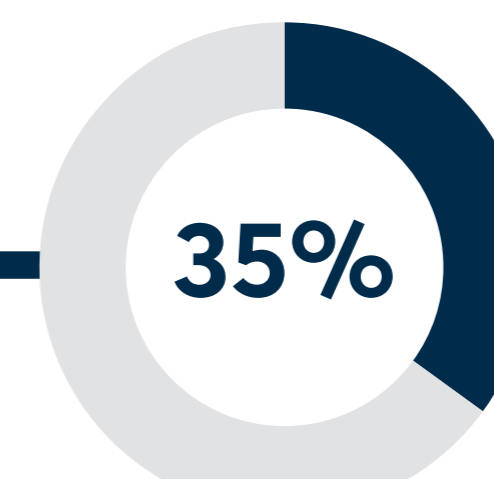
#### Why do you visit Council managed parks and reserves?\*

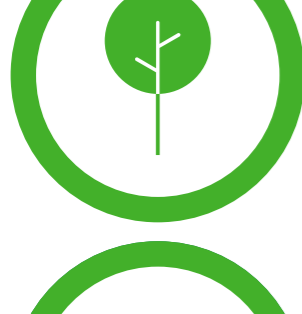

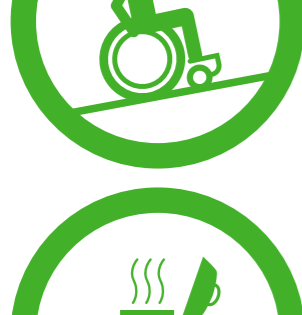
#### Five most important features or elements of parks and reserves that should be protected for current and future generations:\*
