Support for the concept plan:



87%

113 respondents supported the concept plan



39%

49 respondents liked that shade options were provided



24%

30 respondents appreciated the variety of equipment that was proposed

28% of respondents chose the **NATURAL LOGS** option from the Imaginative & Nature Play

36% of respondents chose the **TRAMPOLINES** option from the Active Play



31% of respondents chose the **ROPES NET CHALLENGE** option from the Crawling & Balancing choices
