

# DUNDAS PARK

## NETBALL COURT UPGRADE



City of Parramatta Council is working with the local community to deliver improvements to the Dundas Park Netball Court. Stage one consultation was delivered between 1 December and 23 December 2022. The scope of the works included:

- Retaining netball functions
- The court will remain enclosed/fenced
- Similar to Dunrossil Park in Carlingford, the court could be used for netball in winter and other sports at other times

### Upgrade recommendations

**Stage 1:**  
Court surface repairs,  
fencing, lighting, drinking  
fountain & pathway

**Stage 2:**  
Shelter with seating

**Stage 3:**  
Re-painting court  
surface in Spring\*

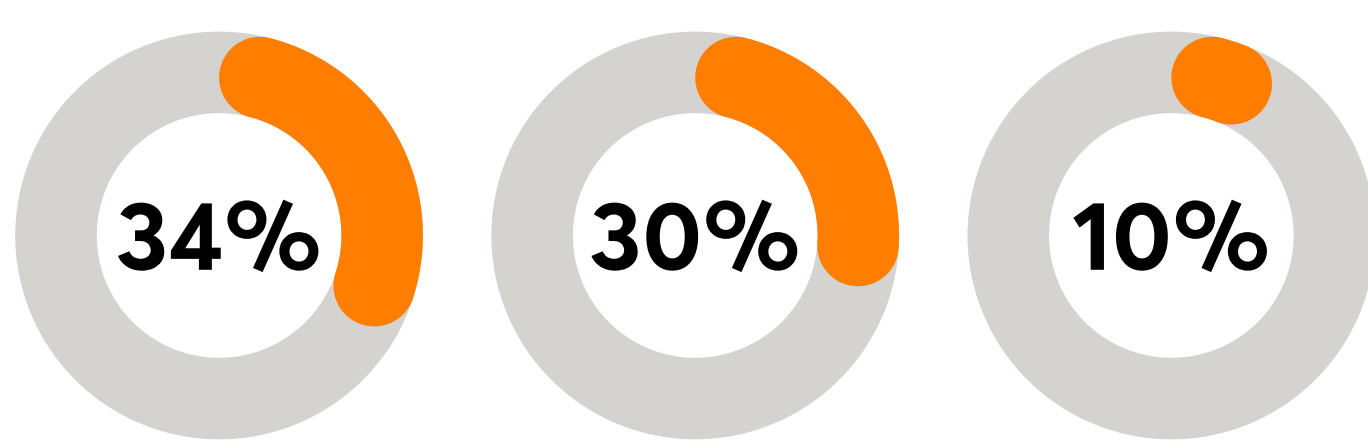
\*The surface will have multi-purpose lines with the primary sport in winter to be netball and the primary sport in summer to be tennis

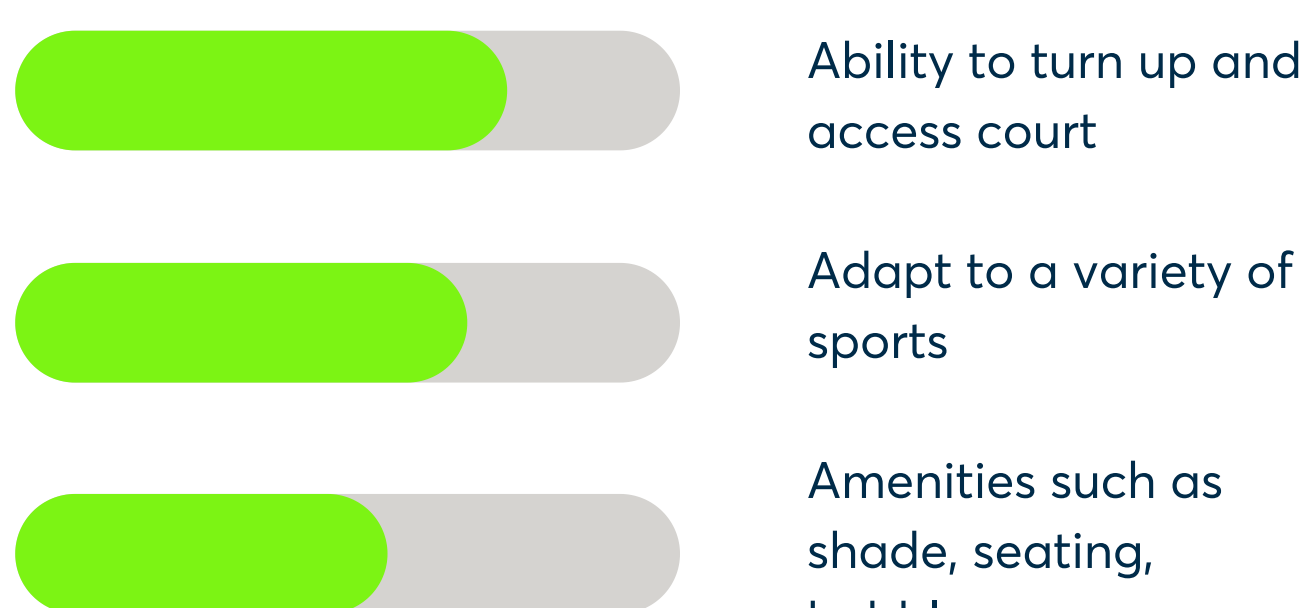

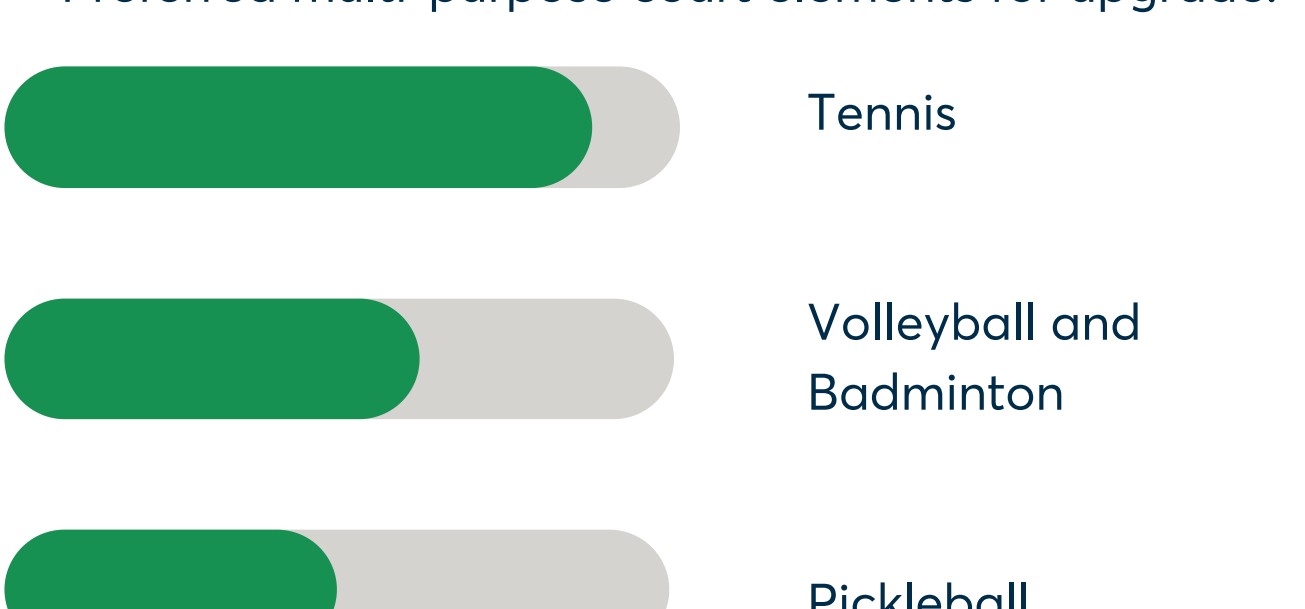

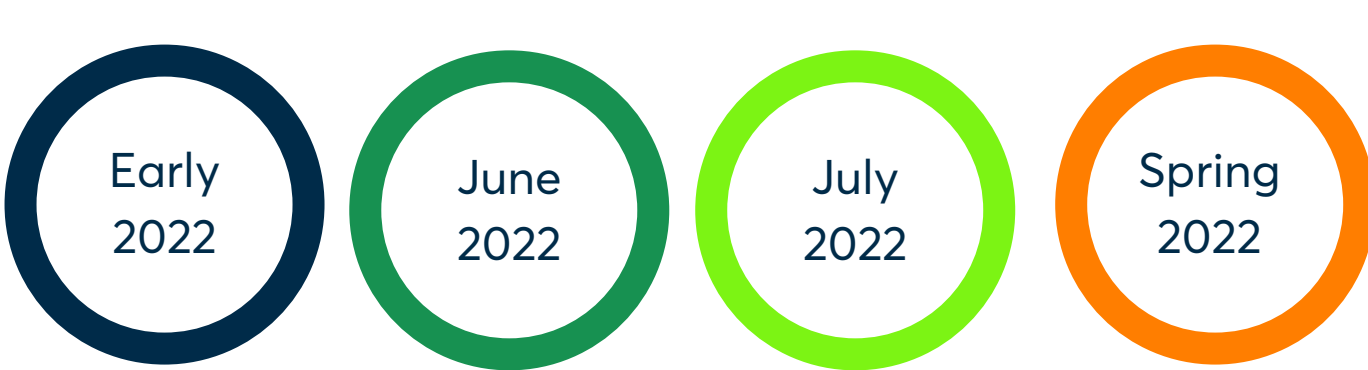
The most important aspects of a court:
