


Development in design

- Changes to ramp to ensure compliance and best head clearance
- Addition of glazing throughout
- Storage added to multipurpose room 2
- Option for notice board / Display
- Bubbler and bin storage added to built in joinery
- Dedicated office, storage reduced
- Thoroughfare direct from carpark to multipurpose room 3
- Multipurpose room 3 given presentation wall, joinery relocated
- Operable partition between multipurpose room 1 and 2
- Minor change in floor height of quiet study
- New Entry Location along Uhrig Road with large entry foyer
- New panel window to replace the previous gate entry next to the substation.
- More communal lounge study areas in the entry area
- Lobby areas to both sides of the large multi-purpose hall
- A larger quiet study area for registered users
- Three new large multi-purpose rooms that can be hired for various activities. Previously, nominated maker space and a meeting room






Development in design

- Changes to ramp to ensure compliance and best head clearance
- Artwork at slab turn down suggested 1700mmH x 11300mmW
- Option for notice board / Display 2600mmH x 4600mmW
- Bubbler and bin storage added to built in joinery

- 2450mm Ceiling height at interim landing
- 2050mm head height clearance at pinch point
- Subject to performance solution
- 2400mm clear from handrail to digital kiosk
- 2000mm wide corridor
- Digital Kiosk 1800mmW x 2100mmH (can be up to 2800mmH)

Osprey Park

The Eastern Osprey is a medium-sized bird of prey with a dark brown crown and wings that contrast with pale-coloured feathers. The Osprey patrols the river from above searching for food. When prey is identified, the bird will fold its wings, swoop down and snatch food with its talons.

The Osprey is listed as an endangered species due to threats such as egg collection, hunting and tree removal, which have distrupted its nesting practices.

Kestrel Park

The Nankeen Kestrel is a bird with a rich iron colouring, a black-tipped tail, and creamy underparts dotted with brown and black. This raptor is commonly found around open fields and grasslands, searching for small mammals, mice, lizards and insects to eat. It is one of the top ten most commonly seen birds across Australia. Nankeen Kestrels have the ability to hover in one spot, allowing them to search for, identify and then pounce on prey.

Little Eagle Green

The Little Eagle is a small yet powerful bird, with a short broad head and a moderately long tail. Its feathers vary in colour from light to dark brown. A pale broken 'M' across the upperparts and a pale M-shaped band on the underwing are striking features.

The Little Eagle has long, broad wings, spanning over one metre. Although uncommon to the precinct area, the Little Eagle has been observed soaring in tight circles and gliding or up-draughts.


