



## LEGEND

- ① Proposed granite pedestrian paving with new kerb and gutter
- ② Proposed traffic signal upgrade to be undertaken directly by TfNSW (outlined in yellow)
- ③ New kerb ramps and on-grade road pavement treatment to provide visual direction at pedestrian crossings
- ④ Proposed tree planting with tree grate
- ⑤ Proposed tree planting in parking lane with raised concrete kerb around tree pit and mulch understorey
- ⑥ Proposed tree planting in parking lane with raised concrete kerb around tree pit, groundcover plants and irrigation.
- ⑦ Proposed paved shared pedestrian and vehicular laneway with restricted access
- ⑧ Proposed public ramp and stairway access to Cambridge Street as well as fire accessway for School of Arts building.
- ⑨ Proposed feature paving with new street furniture (seats, bollards, bins and decorative laser cut light pillars)
- ⑩ Proposed feature paving, lighting of School of Arts front facade and up-lit trees to highlight heritage features
- ⑪ Proposed asphalt road pavement upgrade and selective kerb replacement
- ⑫ Proposed laneway sitting area with shelter, seating, tree trestles and lighting
- ⑬ Proposed works along Cambridge Street subject to available funding (outlined in yellow)
- ⑭ Existing concrete road pavement to remain
